The new exhibition expands on the artist's interest in language and the social phenomenology of perception.

Using text as the central point of her work, Oshinsky uses homophones and shifting context to disrupt interpretation similarly to that which happens in relationship to the world around us. The displaced words blur comprehension; like a highly intoxicated evening, the altered mind loses love, memory, and sometimes consciousness while travelling through associations.
