Light and Wire Gallery is pleased to present a solo exhibition by Los Angeles artist Lindsay Ljungkull entitled *Un Fit*.

The exhibition will feature two new videos, *Cog* and *Cry*. *Cog* is a working video; the workers in the video go to work, perpetuating the cycle of production. An artist makes work: makes a piece of work and creates work to occupy herself, rather than participating in the work that already exists. The video itself works, and then breaks. *Cry* documents the defiant wail of a young child from two alternating perspectives.

Ljungkull has her MFA from the University of Southern California. She has exhibited her films in various galleries and screening projects, including *Supersonic 2006*, Frieze Art Fair's *Film as Event*, and the Hammer Museum. She was also featured in the New Museum's *Younger Than Jesus Artist Directory*. She has an upcoming show at the USC Gallery 3001 in August of 2010.
